We are a recognized 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, private and independent from Texas State University and any of its organizations. Please review this letter as it includes instructions for submitting a complete application packet. This award is for a leadership development scholarship covering all costs for one Texas State University student to attend Campus Pride's national summer leadership program, Camp *Pride.* All applicants must be enrolled at Texas State University for the fall semester following the *Camp* Pride conference.

The leadership development scholarship is a way to foster leadership and personal growth within the Texas State LGBTOIA and Ally community. By way of Camp Pride, college students around the United States will have access to premiere faculty and national leaders in social justice, human rights, and civil rights advocacy. The recipient of this award will attend *Camp Pride* and develop a personal action plan to make Texas State University more LGBTQIA-friendly. Undergraduate and graduate students are eligible to apply.

In order to be considered for this award, you must:

- Complete the following **application**
- Provide a current **resume**
- Provide an unofficial **transcript** reflecting a Texas State GPA of at least 2.25
- Answer **one** of two essay questions
- Complete the **Scholarship Recipient Agreement** form
- Complete the Code of Conduct and Recipient Responsibility Agreement form
- Obtain **one** completed applicant **recommendation form** (in a sealed envelope, signed across the back)
