



We are excited to announce that we are accepting applications for Bobcat Pride Scholarship Fund® (BPSF) director positions. We are looking for motivated and dedicated individuals who are interested in making a difference in the lives of LGBTQ Texas State Bobcats. Our mission is to support LGBTQ Texas State students by providing educational and leadership scholarships in order to promote retention of an underrepresented community. We are a recognized 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, private and independent from Texas State University and any of its organizations.

We provide four types of support to LGBTQIA Texas State students:

- Academic Achievement Scholarships in the fall and spring semesters
- A Leadership Development Scholarship to attend the national *Camp Pride* in July
- Emergency Stabilization funding to LGBTQIA students facing an unexpected financial situation that could put their educational goals at risk
- Paid internship opportunities for Texas State students

Our volunteer leadership team is a driving force in the success of our nonprofit goals. In order to meet our objectives we meet monthly to carry out the responsibilities needed to achieve our goals. We work with a group of dedicated team members to engage in community outreach and fundraising events. There are three tiers of leadership positions:

Directors- Are board members, make a three year commitment to the position, and cannot be degree seeking students at Texas State University

Team Members- Contribute assistance for specific duties or teams and can be seeking a degree at Texas State University* (bachelor's, master's or doctorate)

Interns- Degree seeking students or recent graduates working under the supervision of Directors*

*degree seeking students are NOT eligible to receive a BSPF scholarship while holding a leadership position

- Provide a **cover letter** that addresses your interest, qualifications, and experiences that equip you for the position based on the job description
