We provide four types of support to LGBTQIA Texas State students:

- Academic Achievement Scholarships in the fall and spring semesters
- A Leadership Development Scholarship to attend the national *Camp Pride* in July
- Emergency Stabilization funding to LGBTQIA students facing an unexpected financial situation that could put their educational goals at risk
- Paid internship opportunities for Texas State students

Team members are presented with opportunities to assist with tasks, be part of planning teams for larger events, and/or help out at events.
